TIP 04

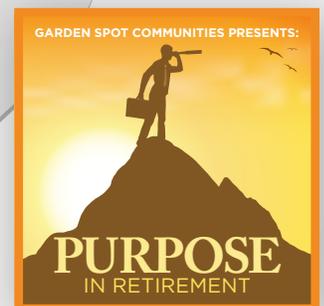
Help Rebuild.
